Agenda No.: 06: Payment of Remuneration of Ayurveda GDMO, Specialist, Pharmacist and Panchkarama Therapist/Technician under the MoU between Ministry of Ayush and Directorate General, Defence Estates (DGDE), Ministry of Defence (MoD)- reg.

To consider the letter of the PDDE, Western Command, Chandigarh No.4/Gen/CGH/C/DE/WD/Vol-5/RMS932179/117 dated 19.11.2024 alongwith the directions of the DGDE, Raksha Sampda Bhawan, Delhi Cantt No.76/12/AYUSH/Ayurveda/C/DE/ 2022/Vol-VI/ dated 18.11.2024 and Director General, Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences, New Delhi vide letter No.2-5/2022-CCRAS/Rectt/Vol.1/5031 dated 13.11.2024, directed therein that the expenditure towards pay, allowances, or remuneration as well as supply of Ayurvedic Medicines to all Cantonments Hospital covered under the MoU signed 11.10.2024, will be borne by the Ministry of Defence w.e.f. 11.10.2024.

Office Note:

This Board is already running an Ayurveda Centre in the Cantt General Hospital, wherein the Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Science department, New Delhi (Ministry of Ayush) is paying the remuneration to the Ayurveda Doctor and Pharmacist and also providing the Medicines free of cost. A consolidated sum of Rs.50,000/- is being paid to the Ayurveda Doctor and Rs.30,000/- to the Ayurveda Pharmacist through CCRAS. Recently an MoU has been signed between Ministry of Ayush And DGDE, Ministry of Defence on 11.10.2024 which is effective from 20.04.2024 for additional 02 years i.e. 20.04.2024 to 19.04.2026 as per the new addendum of MoU.

The Ministry of Ayush has also directed that the same staff (Doctors, Pharmacist, Therapist and Technician may be continued till 19.04.2026 vide Office Memorandum of the Ministry of Ayush No. V-15016/3/2022-ADS dated 11.11.2024.

It is also informed to the Board that at present only one Ayurveda Pharmacist is working in the Ayurvedic Centre situated in the Cantonment Board General Hospital.

The Board is requested to approve the remuneration of the following staff required to run the Ayurveda Centre as per the MoU:

1. Avurveda Doctor

Rs.50000/- per month

2. Ayurveda Pharmacist

Rs.30000/- per month

3. Ayurveda Medicine required time to time Rs.3.5 to 4.00 lakhs per annum

The Board may approve the above mentioned remuneration to be paid to the Ayurveda Doctor and Pharmacist through the Outsourced Manpower Agency only.
